- M** Complete the [Student Health Insurance Requirement Waiver Form](#). You can submit a copy of your VA ID Card or Active-Duty ID card to waive the Health Insurance Requirement. Visit healthinsurance.syr.edu for more information.
- M** Complete the [Request for Benefit Certification form](#) from the Veterans Resource Center. You will need to make this request every semester you request benefits. There is not a separate application for Yellow Ribbon benefits; you will be awarded Yellow Ribbon automatically if eligible.
- M** Submit a copy of your Certificate of Eligibility (COE) to the Veterans Resource Center. The VA form 22-1990 or 22-1990E can be completed online through the [Veterans Online Application \(VONAPP\)](#). Questions? Email veterans@syr.edu.
- Schedule an appointment with your VA VetSuccess On Campus (VSOC) Counselor, Kate Untiedt, to review possible benefits while you are attending training and discuss your transition to campus. Contact Kate Untiedt at 315.443.0177 or Katherine.Untiedt@va.gov.
- Submit your [Joint Service Transcript \(JST\)](#) or [Community College of the Air Force \(CCAF\) transcripts](#) to your home school or college to receive any applicable transfer credits for your military service.
